



Proclamation

WHEREAS: exceptional children have unrecognized talents and abilities; and

WHEREAS: exceptional children merit the opportunity to display such talents and abilities; and

WHEREAS: there exists at present no vehicle for this purpose; and

WHEREAS: a need for such a vehicle has been recognized by the College of St. Thomas through the First Annual Exceptional Children's Fair, May 10; and

WHEREAS: such recognition enhances all children's self-confidence and positive self-image;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim May 10, 1975 as

EXCEPTIONAL CHILDREN'S DAY

in Minnesota.
