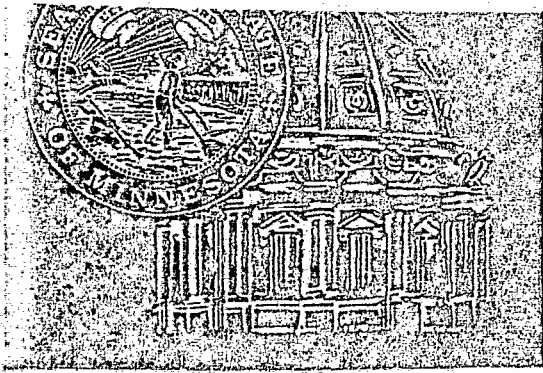




Proclamation
