

# Printer's Affidavit of Publication

John E. West being duly sworn, deposes and says that he now is and during all the times hereinafter mentioned has been the publisher or printer in charge of The Swanville News, a weekly newspaper, printed and published in the Village of Swanville, in said Morrison County, State of Minnesota, on Friday of each week;

That he has knowledge of the facts and knows personally that the printed Ordinance hereto attached, cut from the columns of said newspaper, was inserted, printed and published in said newspaper once in each week for one weeks, and that all of said publications were made in the English language.

That said notice was first inserted, printed and published on Friday, the 24 day of March, 1922 and was printed and published in said newspaper on each and every Friday thereafter until and including Friday, the \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_, 1922.

That during all the times aforesaid, said newspaper was qualified as a medium of official and legal publications as required by sections 3 and 4 of chapter 484, Session Laws of Minnesota, 1921, and that it has complied with all the requirements that constitute a legal newspaper as defined in said sections 3 and 4, to-wit: that for more than one year last past from the date of the first publication of said notice, said newspaper has been

(1) Printed from the place from which it purports to be issued in the English language, and in column and sheet form equivalent in space to at least four pages, with five columns to the page, each seventeen and three quarters inches long.

(2) Issued once each week from a known office, established in such place for publication and equipped with skilled workmen and the necessary material for preparing and printing the same.

(3) Made up to contain general and local news, comment and miscellany, not wholly duplicating any other publication, and not entirely made up of patents, plate matter and advertisements, or any or either of them.

(4) Circulated in and near its place of publication to the extent of at least two hundred and forty copies regularly delivered to paying subscribers, and that prior to the date of the first publication of said notice the publisher or printer in charge of said newspaper having knowledge of the facts, filed in the office of the county auditor of said County of Morrison, State of Minnesota, an affidavit showing the name and location of said newspaper and the existence of conditions constituting its qualifications as a legal newspaper as required and set forth in section 3 of chapter 484, Session Laws Minnesota, 1921.

That the following is a printed copy of the lower case alphabet from A to Z both inclusive, of the size and kind of type used in the composition, printing and publication of said legal advertisement hereunto attached, viz:

abcdefghijklmnopqrstuvwxyz.

Further aforesaid saith not, save that this affidavit is made pursuant to section 4 of chapter 484, Session Laws Minnesota, 1921, and is intended to accompany the bill for the publication in said newspaper of the aforesaid legal advertisement.

Ordinance No. 34

An ordinance extending the village of Swanville, Minnesota, so as to include the following described real estate, to-wit: Blocks One, Two and Three together with Streets and Alleys as shown by plot thereof now on Record in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for the County of Morrison and State of Minnesota.

The Village Council of the Village of Swanville do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1.

That the boundaries of the village of Swanville, Minnesota be, and the same hereby are, extended so as to include a piece or parcel of land, abutting upon said village, known and platted as McRae's addition to Swanville and described as follows, to-wit: Blocks 1, Two and Three together with Street and Alleys as shown by plot thereof now on file in the Office of the Register of Deeds in and for the County of Morrison and State of Minnesota.

SECTION 2.

That said real estate be, and the same hereby is made, to constitute, for all purposes, a part of the said village of Swanville, subject in all respects to the government of the said village.

SECTION 3.

That this ordinance take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and publication.
