



Proclamation

- REAS: Rabbi Bernard Raskas has served the Temple of Aaron Congregation since 1951; and
- REAS: under his guidance, and with the inspiration of his wife, Laeh, Rabbi Raskas has brought innovation, excitement and interest to religious services at the Temple of Aaron; and
- REAS: the Congregation has grown from 600 families, at the time Rabbi Raskas became spiritual leader, to 1,200 families in 1975; and
- REAS: in April of this year, Rabbi Raskas received the degree of Doctor of Divinity from the Jewish Theological Seminary of America; and
- REAS: Rabbi Raskas was the first Jewish Chaplain of the Minnesota Legislature and has served on a most impressive number of community Boards of Directors ranging from the St. Paul Area Chamber of Commerce and the United Way to the Human Rights Commission; and
- REAS: Rabbi Raskas is a published writer, has served as Fine Arts Chairman for the Rabbinical Assembly of America, is a Board Member of the Jewish Museum in New York and currently is chairman of the National Enrollment Plan of the Jewish Theological Seminary of America; and
- REAS: Laeh Raskas participates in the Temple of Aaron Sisterhood and is a member of all the Jewish women's organizations in the community; and
- REAS: she is a member of the Board of the United Jewish Fund and Council of St. Paul and has served as its Campaign Chairwoman; and
- REAS: on May 13, Rabbi and Mrs. Raskas are being honored by the Family of the Temple of Aaron for their dedicated leadership and service to the community;
