WHEREAS: the Mankato State College Band Department is sponsoring a concert on Sunday, May 18, at the Theater of the Performing Arts Center; and

WHEREAS: the purpose of this concert is to help raise money for young musicians to attend Lake Washington Band Camp; and

WHEREAS: the goal for this venture is to provide at least ten scholarships for musicians in the area who otherwise would be unable to avail themselves of this enrichment;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Sunday, May 18, 1975 to be
