



# Proclamation

WHEREAS: forty-six member congregations of the American Lutheran Church form the basis of Ebenezer Society in the church community; and

WHEREAS: Ebenezer Society is one of the largest geriatric complexes in the country, serves over 800 elderly people within its facilities, and nearly 1,400 more through outreach programs in the Twin Cities metropolitan community; and

WHEREAS: Ebenezer Society is recreating happy memories for residents whose early lives were spent in a rural environment, through sight, touch, sound and smell of farm animals on June 7, 1975; and

WHEREAS: this event is made possible through the cooperation and assistance of the young men and women of Future Farmers of America of Chaska;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Saturday, June 7, 1975 to be
