

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 106

Providing for assistance to
officials of the State of Minnesota

I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of
the authority vested in me by the Constitution and applicable statutes, hereby
issue this Executive Order:

WHEREAS, officials of the State of Minnesota request assistance to
alleviate emergency conditions caused by floods:

NOW THEREFORE, I order that:

1. The Adjutant General of Minnesota will order to active duty in the
service of the state, such elements of the military forces of the
state as are required to expedite the determination of flood con-
ditions in the State of Minnesota. These elements will assist state
authorities with appropriate support as required.
2. Cost of subsistence, transportation and fuel, pay and allowances
of said individuals will be defrayed from the General Revenue of
the State, as provided for by Minnesota statutes, Section 192.49;
Subdivision 1, Section 192.51; and Section 192.52.

This Order shall be effective on 2 May 1975.
