



Proclamation

WHEREAS: the United States Army, throughout its two hundred years of existence, has provided for the common defense of our Nation and our State, responding to the call to arms with distinction and honor; and

WHEREAS: the State of Minnesota has given freely of her sons and daughters to the service of the United States Army; and

WHEREAS: the citizens of the State of Minnesota, together with the men and women of the United States Army, Army National Guard and Army Reserve live and work in close partnership based on interdependence and respect;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim June 14, 1975 as

UNITED STATES ARMY DAY

in Minnesota, and urge all of our citizens to observe this day by addressing their attention to the past and present accomplishments and contributions made by the United States Army, the Army National Guard and the Army Reserve.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this fifth day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventy-five and of the State, the one hundred and seventeenth.
