WHEREAS: Variety Club Tent 12 is an organization of compassionate persons, whose special mission is the welfare of children; and

WHEREAS: Variety Club fights heart disease with its construction of and continuing support for the University of Minnesota Heart Hospital; and

WHEREAS: Variety Club of the Northwest committed five million dollars to build a Cardiovascular Research and Training Center adjacent to the Heart Hospital; and

WHEREAS: Variety Club, through the Regents of the University of Minnesota, is dedicating this Center to the people of Minnesota on Thursday, June 19, 1975 with a ceremony at Coffman Memorial Union;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim June 15 - 21, 1975 as
