in Minnesota, and call upon all officials of state and local government, civic organizations, educational institutions, and citizens to observe International Women's Year in recognition of the need to promote full equality of opportunity between men and women, and also to cooperate with the activities and observances arranged under the auspices of the United Nations.

FURTHERMORE, BE IT KNOWN that Eugenie Anderson has long been identified with the status of women, as well as national and international policies, and that Minnesota is fortunate indeed to have an individual with her courage, commitment and accomplishments as United Nations Day Chairperson for our State.
