

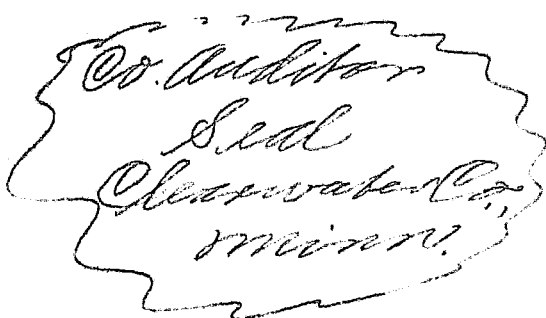

To the Board of County Commissioners
of the County of Clearwater, Minnesota :

The undersigned electors, residents upon the following described lands, which have been partly platted into lots and blocks, and upon lands adjacent thereto, in the County of Clearwater and State of Minnesota, and not in any incorporated village, which said plat has been duly and legally certified according to the laws of this state, and filed in the office of the register of deeds for the county of Clearwater and State of Minnesota, being the county in which said lands lie, to-wit:

The east half of the northeast quarter ($E\frac{1}{2}NE\frac{1}{4}$) of section numbered eight (8) and the northeast quarter ($NE\frac{1}{4}$) of section numbered nine (9), all in township one hundred forty-eight (148) North of Range thirty-six (36), West of the Fifth Principal Meridian in Clearwater County, Minnesota; and

Beginning at the southeast corner of the southwest quarter of the southeast quarter of section eight (8) in said township and range, thence due north for a distance of one-half mile and following the east boundary line of the west half of the southeast quarter of said section eight (8) to the southwest corner of the southeast quarter of the northeast quarter in said section eight (8), thence due east for a distance of three-fourths of a mile and following the south boundary line of the southeast quarter of the northeast quarter in said section eight (8) and also following the south boundary line of the northwest quarter of section nine (9) in said township and range to the southeast corner of the northwest quarter of said section nine (9) thence due south following the east boundary line of lot numbered six (6) in said section nine according to the United States Government Survey thereof as returned by the Surveyor General, to a point where said east boundary line of said lot six (6) intersects the meander line of that certain body of water or lake known and called by the name of Four Legged Lake, thence following the meander line of said lake in a southerly direction to a point where said meander line intersects the ~~north~~ south boundary line of Lot one (1) in above ment-

ioned section eight (8), thence due west following the south boundary line of said Lot one (1) to the point of beginning and there terminate.

All of foregoing described land proposed to be incorporated into a village and embraced within the limits thereof containing three hundred eighty-two and 25/100 (382.25) acres, and that the resident population thereof is not more than three thousand nor less than one hundred, and is so conditioned as to be properly subjected to village government.

Therefore, we hereby petition your Honorable Board to appoint a time and place when and where the electors actually residing upon said lands may vote for or against the incorporation in accordance with the provisions of law prescribed for the incorporation of villages by sections 1204 to 1209 inclusive of the 1913 General Statutes of Minnesota and acts amendatory thereof, of a village to be named LEONARD.

That the number of persons actually residing within and upon said territory are one hundred and fifty (150) as has been duly ascertained by a census taken under our direction on the twenty-eighth day of April, 1922, as appears by the verifications hereto.

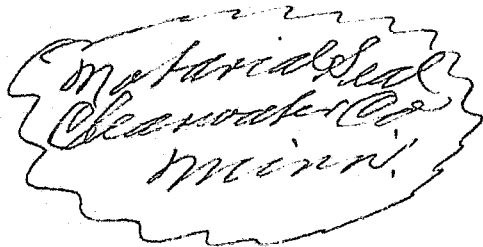
