



# Proclamation

WHEREAS: the baton twirling movement has affected the lives of American girls and boys, and now has nearly one million active participants; and

WHEREAS: baton twirling has been instrumental in building the confidence and character of these young people, and has provided guidance and training so that they might become better qualified citizens; and

WHEREAS: the art of baton twirling is today the second largest nationwide beneficial youth movement for girls; and

WHEREAS: baton twirling plays an important part in children's hospitals as a unique and effective method of physical therapy; and

WHEREAS: baton twirlers lend so much color and inspiration to our community celebrations, parades, school events and other activities; and

WHEREAS: champion twirlers from all of the United States will gather at the University of Notre Dame in August to conduct a colorful youth pageant called "America's Youth on Parade";

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim July 27 to August 2, 1975, as

in Minnesota, and do urge our citizens to support the colorful and beneficial youth movement of baton twirling, which is of such importance to the youth of our state and to youth everywhere.
