



Proclamation

WHEREAS: more than ten million people in the United States now enjoy the game of golf including the present occupant of the Governor's office; and

WHEREAS: Central States Golf Association was organized 44 years ago to give Black golf players an opportunity to play in tournaments; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota, Iowa and Illinois were the first three states to join CSGA and today this number has grown to fifteen; and

WHEREAS: the goal of CSGA is to introduce aspiring young golfers to the game as a healthful recreation that encourages good sportsmanship, and to further their educational experience through the CSGA scholarship fund; and

WHEREAS: the Twin City Golf Club will be host to more than 600 golfers during the 45th Annual Central States Golf Tournament in Minneapolis from July 12 through July 17;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, do hereby proclaim July 12 through July 17, 1975 to be

in Minnesota, and on behalf of all citizens, welcome participants, and wish them a most successful tournament and pleasant stay in our state.
