



Proclamation

WHEREAS: the Pre-Engineered Metal Building Industry has made a significant impact on the economy of Minnesota for more than three decades; and

WHEREAS: the Metal Building Industry in Minnesota is responsible for hundreds of the jobs in several manufacturing plants, additional hundreds in builder-dealer firms and thousands of jobs in sub-contracting firms; and

WHEREAS: Metal Buildings accounted for approximately one hundred million dollars of construction in Minnesota during 1974; and

WHEREAS: the Northland Chapter of the Metal Building Dealers Association is one of the largest, strongest and most progressive chapters in the nation;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of September 1 - 6, 1975 as

METAL BUILDING WEEK

in Minnesota, and urge all citizens to be aware of this worthy observance.
