

Notice is hereby given, that in accordance with a petition for that purpose, hereto attached, presented by the requisite number of legal voters, an election will be held at ^{In Townsite of Palisade Minn.} I. O. O. F. Hall ^{within the limits} of the proposed village, as stated in said petition, on ^{Wednesday} the ^{31st} day of ^{May} 1922 between the hours of ^{9 A.} ^{M.} and ^{7 P.} M. at which time and place the resident electors thereof will vote for or against incorporation under the General Statutes of Minnesota for 1913 and amendments thereto as provided by law.

TO THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF AITKIN MINNESOTA:

The undersigned electors, residents upon the following described lands, which have been partly platted into lots and blocks, and upon lands adjacent thereto, in the County of Aitkin and State of Minnesota, and not in any incorporated village, which said plat has been duly and legally certified according to the laws of this State, and filed in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for said Aitkin County in which the whole of said lands lie. Said lands and said territory is described as follows:

The South-east quarter of Section Twenty-two (22) of Township Forty-nine North of Range Twenty-five West of the Fourth Principal Meridian which land above described includes the plat of the Townsite of Palisade in accordance with the recorded plat on file and of record in the office of Register of Deeds in and for said County of Aitkin also North-west quarter of the North-east quarter and Lot One (1) of Section Twenty-seven of Town and Range aforesaid

that the same comprises Two hundred and twenty-nine (229) acres, that the resident population of same is One hundred and thirty-six (136) hereby petition your honorable board to appoint a time and place when and where the electors actually residing upon said lands may vote for or against the incorporation under the General Statutes of Minnesota for 1913 and amendments thereto, of a village to be named Palisade. The number of persons actually residing in said territory is One hundred and thirty-six (136) as has been ascertained by a census taken under our direction on the first day of May 1922 as appears by the verifications hereto.

the Board of Commissioners of the County of Aitkin, Minnesota, met at the Court House in the Village of Aitkin, Minnesota, on the 3rd day of May 1922, the following members being present:

W. W. Rabay, Fred R. Heft, C. A. Maddy, O. P. Langerud and Andrew Larson

Fred R. Heft -- a member of said board offered the following preambles and resolutions and moved their adoption:

WHEREAS a petition has been presented to the board of Commissioners of Aitkin County, Minnesota, petitioning for the calling of an election to determine a proposed incorporation of a village in Aitkin County, to be known as the Village of Palisade and

WHEREAS said petition has been approved by said county board of commissioners, Now Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, that said election shall be held on the 31st day of May 1922 and that a copy of said petition with a notice of election attached thereto, be posted in three public places within the boundaries in said petition described on or before May 6th 1922; that such notice attached to said petition shall be in substantially the following form:
