



ORDINANCE NO. 361

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS
OF THE CITY OF DETROIT LAKES, MINNESOTA
TO INCLUDE CERTAIN LANDS

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DETROIT LAKES, MINNESOTA, DOES ORDAIN:

Section 1. A petition has been filed with the governing body of the City of Detroit Lakes, Minnesota, by the owners of the following described real estate, to have such land included within the City of Detroit Lakes, Minnesota:

That part of Lot 12 of Bowman's Subdivision, plat of which is on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds, Becker County, Minnesota, less the following described tract:

Commencing at the Northeast corner of Lot 12; thence Westerly 7 feet on the Northwestern boundary of Lot 12; thence Southeasterly 300 feet to the meander line of Detroit Lakes; thence Northwesternly on the Easterly line of Lot 12, 300 feet to the point of beginning,

and

Lots 13 through 26, inclusive, of said Bowman's Subdivision,

and

That part of Government Lot 5, Section 4, Township 138 North, Range 41 West of the Fifth Principal Meridian lying Southerly of Government Lot 2, Easterly and Southeasterly of the St. Paul & Sault Ste. Marie railroad and Northerly of the in place public road commonly known as Munson Lake Road (CSAH No. 6) and lying Westerly and Northwesternly of said Bowman's Subdivision.

Section 2. The City Council, pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, Section 414.033, Subd. 5, held a hearing on the subject matter at 7:30 P. M. March 4, 1975, after at least 30 days published notice. At the conclusion of said hearing, the City Council determined that:


1. The annexation will be in the best interests of the City of Detroit Lakes, Minnesota, and of the territory affected.
2. The territory described herein abuts upon the City of Detroit Lakes and is so conditioned as property to be subjected to the city government.
3. The area to be annexed consists of approximately 25.3 acres, 15 residences occupied by 38 people; and that the official population of the City of Detroit Lakes should include the additional 38 people.

Section 3. Therefore, the Council of the City of Detroit Lakes, Minnesota, hereby ordains and declares that the property hereinbefore described be and the same hereby is annexed to and included in the City of Detroit Lakes, Minnesota, as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall be final and shall take effect and be in force from and after filing certified copy thereof with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the County Auditor, the Secretary of State, and the Clerk of the Town Board, and from and after its passage and publication.


