ORDINANCE NO. 362

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF DETROIT LAKES, MINNESOTA TO INCLUDE CERTAIN LANDS

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DETROIT LAKES, MINNESOTA, DOES ORDAIN:

Section 1. A petition has been filed with the governing body of the City of Detroit Lakes, Minnesota, by the owners of the following described real estate, to have such land included within the City of Detroit Lakes, Minnesota:

That part of the Northwest Quarter (NW4) of the Northwest Quarter (NW4) of Section 26, Township 139 North, Range 41 West of the Fifth Principal Meridian in Becker County, Minnesota, described as follows:

Commencing at the Northwest corner of said Section 26; thence South 89° 30' 36" East 500 feet along the North line of said Section 26 to the point of beginning; thence continuing South 89° 30' 36" East a distance of 366.34 feet along the North line of said Section 26; thence South 00° 52' 00" West a distance of 1314.45 feet to the North line of Nor-Lake 2nd Addition, plat of which is on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds, Becker County, Minnesota; thence Westerly along the North line of said Nor-Lake 2nd Addition a distance of 616.15 feet; thence North 773.69 feet, more or less, parallel to the West line of said Section 26 to a point on a line which is 541 feet South of and measured at right angles to and parallel with the North line of said Section 26; thence Easterly along the said parallel line to the intersection with a line bearing 02⁰ 38^{*} 31" West from the point of beginning; thence North 02⁰ 38^{*} 31" East a distance of 541 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning.
