



ORDINANCE NO. 75-8

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF FARIBAULT, MINNESOTA TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED UNPLATTED LAND NOT EXCEEDING 200 ACRES IN AREA ABUTTING UPON THE CITY LIMITS.

WHEREAS, a certain petition dated March 31, 1975 requesting annexation of territory described hereinafter was duly presented to the council of the City of Faribault, Minnesota, at a regular meeting thereof held on the 27th day of May, 1975 at 7:30 P.M., and was duly considered by that body; and

WHEREAS, the quantity of land embraced within the area described in said petition and bounded as described therein is approximately 120 acres of unplatted land, no part of which is included within the limits of an incorporated city, village or borough; and

WHEREAS, the petition was signed by all owners of such land; and

WHEREAS, no objections to such annexation have been received from the town board, the county board, or the governing body of any municipality whose boundaries abut upon the boundaries of the land to be annexed; and

WHEREAS, the town board of Wells Township, Rice County, Minnesota, the Board of County Commissioners of Rice County, Minnesota, and the City of Faribault, Minnesota, by authority of its council, have all executed waivers of objections to the proposed annexation of land; and

WHEREAS, the land described in such petition abuts upon the city limits of the City of Faribault, Minnesota at a northerly or more northerly boundary thereof; and

WHEREAS, such annexation will be to the best interests of the municipality and territory affected,

NOW THEREFORE, the council of the City of Faribault do ordain:

Section 1. DETERMINATION. The city council hereby determines (1) the annexation will be to the best interests of the city and of the territory affected; (2) the territory described herein abuts upon the city limits and is about to become urban or suburban in character; and (3) none of said territory is now included within the limits of any city, village, or borough.

Section 2. TERRITORY ANNEXED. The corporate limits of the city are hereby extended to include the unplatted land described as follows and the same is hereby annexed to and included within the city of Faribault, Minnesota as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof:

ALL of the following parcels in Section 24, Township 110 North, Range 21 West of the Fifth Principal Meridian, in Rice County, Minnesota:

PARCEL ONE: The Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$).

PARCEL TWO: The West One-half (W $\frac{1}{2}$) of the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$), excepting therefrom the West 33 feet of the South 700 feet thereof, subject, however, to an easement for roadway purposes over and across said West 33 feet to provide access from the old Shieldsville Road to said PARCELS ONE and TWO, as reserved in quit claim deed of record in the office of the Register of Deeds for said County in Book 253 of Deeds, page 237.

PARCEL THREE: All that part of the Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) lying westerly of the right of way line of the Chicago, Milwaukee, St. Paul and Pacific Railroad Company.

PARCEL FOUR: The East One-half (E $\frac{1}{2}$) of the Southwest One-quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Northeast One-quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) and the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) lying west of the railroad right of way.

Section 3. FILING. The city recorder is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Secretary of State, the Rice County Auditor, and the Town Clerk.

Section 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect 10 days from and after its passage and publication or 10 days from and after the filing of the certified copies as described in Section 3 above, whichever occurs later in point of time.
