Dear Sir:

Make up and deliver to our department within ten days 1500 pair of number plates for tax exempt motor vehicles. The plates are to be of the size and design as agreed upon in personal conversation between Mr. J. P. Bengton and Mr. T. R. Willwersheid in the office of the Secretary of State, at the State Capitol, on May 25.

The words "TAX EXEMPT-21-23" to read across the top of the plate, the abbreviation "MINN" vertically along the left edge and the serial number to be in characters as on the Colorado plate. The color is to be dark brown background with all raised designs in white. The pairs of plates are to be numbered serially beginning with one and ending with 1500. The price must not exceed 25 cents per pair. Plates are to be packed in envelopes similar to those in use for A series plates, one pair for each envelope.


