- WHEREAS: communication through precise verbal expression is an important goal of our educational systems; and
- WHEREAS: interscholastic debate constitutes one of our schools' most significant extra-curricular activities; and
- WHEREAS: Minnesota Independent School District 197 has a proud tradition of forensic excellence under coach Craig Bucher; and
- WHEREAS: Henry Sibley Senior High School students Helen Fisk and Dwight Rabuse won the Debate Championship of the National Speech Tournament; and
- WHEREAS: this is the first Debate Championship for a Minnesota School in the history of National Forensic League competition; and
- WHEREAS: this National Championship brings honor to the Henry Sibley Senior High School Debate Team, the School District and the State of Minnesota; and
- WHEREAS: the achievement of these students and their coach has been recognized by the Independent School District 197 Board of Education and the community;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Tuesday, September 9, 1975, as
