WHEREAS: the Foster Grandparent Program began nationally ten years ago, and Minnesota was one of the 20 original participants; and

WHEREAS: the Foster Grandparent Program is a highly successful program that provides love, companionship, and special activities to more than 600 exceptional children in Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: the 300 senior citizens who serve as Foster Grandparents in this state, themselves, benefit by a close relationship with a child, alleviating their own loneliness and making them feel needed;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, hereby proclaim September 1975 as

NATIONAL FOSTER GRANDPARENT MONTH

in Minnesota, and do extend my special good wishes and congratulations to all the people who have participated in this worthwhile program during the past ten years.
