WHEREAS: it has vigorously and wholeheartedly participated in all efforts toward an America that will provide needed social welfare services, and economy of full employment, and a comfortable livelihood for all Americans; and

WHEREAS: it has inscribed in the minds and hearts of many Americans the need to pursue the cause of social progress and live by the principles of mutual understanding among all peoples; and

WHEREAS: it has set high standards of cultural living and education, more specifically, pioneering in consumers and cooperative health-plans, credit union movement and helping our Indian youth, by assisting and encouraging them to strive for higher horizons through advanced education; and

WHEREAS: this renowned fraternal insurance society has achieved its 75th anniversary and still continues to perform the commendable tasks which have earned it the esteem of our community;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of September 3, 1975 as

WORKMEN'S CIRCLE ANNIVERSARY WEEK

in Minnesota, and do hereby urge all the citizens of our State to share in the meaning and spirit of this occasion and join in greeting The Workmen's Circle on its 75th Jubilee.
