



Proclamation

WHEREAS: it is through the assimilation of many national groups and diverse cultures that Minnesota has formed a strong and vigorous society; and

WHEREAS: the purpose of the Minnesota Federation of Croatian Fraternal Union of American Lodges is to keep the Croatian traditions alive and to help the younger generation to understand the customs, dance, music and language; and

WHEREAS: through such annual celebrations can be created a spirit of fraternalism and pride amongst our people for their heritage and recognition of the fact that such spirit has much to offer America in the years to come;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Sunday, August 31, 1975 as

15th ANNUAL CROATIAN DAY

in Minnesota, and urge all of our citizens to mark this observance, paying tribute to the outstanding contribution made by the people of Croatian descent to Minnesota.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this eighteenth day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and twenty-five and of the State, the one hundred and seventeenth.
