## ORDINANCE NO. 197

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF LONG PRAIRIE TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED, UNPLATTED LAND ABUTTING UPON THE VILLAGE LIMITS.

WHEREAS, a certain petition, dated June 3, 1974, requesting annexation of the territory hereinafter described was duly presented to the Council on the 3rd day of June, 1974, and

WHEREAS, the quantity of land embraced with the area described in the petition and bounded as described is less than two hundred (200) acres of unplatted land, being approximately 8 acres, no part of which is included within the limits of an incorporated city, village or borough, and

WHEREAS, the petition was signed by all of the owners of said property, and

WHEREAS, the Town Board no longer objects to the annexation and no objection has been received from the county board, or the governing body of any municipality whose boundaries abut upon the land to be annexed, and

WHEREAS, a copy of said petition was filed with the Town Clerk of Long Prairie Township on June 4, 1974, and the town board has waived in writing any objection to the annexation, and

WHEREAS, the land described in the petition abuts upon the Village limits at the Northeast boundary thereof:

The Council of the Village of Long Prairie, Minnesota, ordains:

Section 1. The Village Council hereby determines:

- (a) That the annexation will be to the best interests of the Village, and of the territory affected.
- (b) That the territory described herein abuts upon the Village limits and is urban or suburban in character.
- (c) That none of the territory is now included within the limits of any city, village or borough.

## Section 2. Territory annexed:

(a) West 2 rods of SW<sub>4</sub><sup>1</sup> of SW<sub>4</sub><sup>1</sup> of Sec. 17, Twp. 129, Range 33.
 West 2 rods of NW<sub>4</sub><sup>1</sup> of SW<sub>4</sub><sup>1</sup> of Sec. 17, Twp. 129, Range 33.
 North 2 rods of NE<sub>4</sub><sup>1</sup> of SE<sub>4</sub><sup>1</sup> of Sec. 18, Twp. 129, Range 33.
 West 2 rods of SE<sub>4</sub><sup>1</sup> of NE<sub>4</sub><sup>1</sup> of Sec. 18, Twp. 129, Range 33.

Section 3. Filing. The Village Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Secretary of State and the County Auditor.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication and filing of the certified copies as directed in Section 3.
