

Proclamation

WHEREAS: August 25 will be celebrated as the 150th Anniversary of Uruguay's Independence; and

WHEREAS: the year 1975 is to be known as Año de la Orientalidad -- the Year of Republica Oriental del Uruguay; and

WHEREAS: Uruguay rejoices that its independence was inspired by the same desire as the United States of America to assure freedom and democracy for her people; and

WHEREAS: as a trading partner of the United States of America, Uruguay has indicated that it wishes to encourage, promote and stimulate the development of its resources, the enhancement of its agribusiness, and the progress of its industry, trade and commerce through trade expansion, investment and travel; and

WHEREAS: in the "Partners of the Americas" program, Uruguay is the sister state of Minnesota with Montivideo, Minnesota and Montivideo, Uruguay sharing close ties;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim August 25, 1975 to be

URUGUAY DAY

in Minnesota, and request that all concerned lend support to the efforts being made to assure that the trade, progress, and economic prosperity of Uruguay, as well as of the United States, are promoted through a greater exchange in goods and services between these two nations, to honor the 200th Anniversary of the United States' Declaration of Independence and Uruguay's 150th Anniversary of Independence.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this twenty-first day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventy-five and of the State the one hundred seventeenth.
