STATE OF MINNESOTA DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION REORGANIZATION ORDER NO. 56

Pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 1974, Sections 16.25, 16.13, and 16.135, the following administrative reorganization is made.
