

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING LAWS 1973
CHAPTER 123 (The Uniform Code of Municipal
Government) AS THE GOVERNING LAW OF
THE CITY OF CROSBY

WHEREAS, pursuant to Minnesota Laws 1973 Ch. 123, Art. V, Sec. 5, Subd. 2, the City of Crosby will cease to be governed by Minnesota Statute 1971 Chapter 205 and be governed by the Uniform Code of Municipal Government on July 1, 1975, unless an earlier change is provided for by resolution; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the citizens and city government that this transition occur as soon as possible, now

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Crosby that upon the filing of this resolution with the Crow Wing County Auditor, the Minnesota State Auditor and the Minnesota Secretary of State, which filing is hereby directed to be made by the clerk (Recorder), the City of Crosby shall henceforth be governed pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 1971, Ch. 412 as amended by Laws 1973, Ch. 123.
