- WHEREAS: the high school student councils provide opportunity for orderly and democratic representation of student interests throughout the State of Minnesota consonant with the traditions of the American way of life; and
- WHEREAS: participation in student councils at the local level and at the annual convention of the Minnesota Association of Student Councils aids in development of the qualities of leadership among the young men and women this State and this Nation must look to for continuation of the American principles of freedom and democracy; and
- WHEREAS: this year's convention clearly and commendably demonstrates the acute perception and leadership of the boys and girls of today who will be tomorrow's America;

AND, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the period of November 6 - 8, 1975 as

in Minnesota, and urge all citizens to appropriately honor this observance and to provide continuing encouragement and inspiration to this outstanding youth organization.
