

Proclamation

WHEREAS: the citizens of Minnesota recognize the importance of higher education for the continued development of the State; and

WHEREAS: prospective students, including present high school and community college students, veterans, and mid-career adults, need adequate information to decide which post-secondary institutions will provide the education they need to fulfill their goals; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota educators have organized a College Fair, sponsored by the National Association of College Admissions Counselors, which will be held in the Minneapolis Convention Center, September 29 and 30, bringing together two and four year colleges and vocational-technical schools in a full-service information setting for parents and students;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim September 29 and 30 to be

COLLEGE FAIR DAYS

in Minnesota, and urge all interested people to participate in this informative event.
