WHEREAS: many young men and women of this state are members of both Junior and Senior ROTC programs; and

WHEREAS: ROTC graduates from the State of Minnesota have served with dedication and distinction as members of the Armed Forces and, later, as leaders in the professional community and their communities at large;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota do hereby proclaim the week of 6 October to 11 October 1975 as
