WHEREAS: the Myasthenia Gravis Foundation is dedicated to educating the medical and lay populations to early recognition of this unusual disease and for supporting research into the cause and treatment of Myasthenia Gravis; and

WHEREAS: Myasthenia Gravis is a disease that causes disability in all age groups with muscle weakness of the eyes, throat and extremities and is often not promptly diagnosed; and

WHEREAS: increased public awareness of this illness is essential for early diagnosis since many patients can be satisfactorily treated; and

WHEREAS: the Myasthenia Gravis Foundation distributes a large portion of the contributed dollar to research;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota do hereby proclaim the period of September 21 - 27, 1975 as
