of St. Paul, Minnesota, as Special Assistant Attorney General to the Department of Human Rights, and fix her compensation at the sum of Fifteen Thousand, Six Hundred (\$15,600) Dollars per annum to be paid from the appropriations made for the Department of Human Rights.

Said Special Assistant Attorney General shall serve at the pleasure of the Attorney General or until this appointment shall be revoked or otherwise terminated in accordance with law. Said appointment shall take effect on the 25th day of August, 1975.

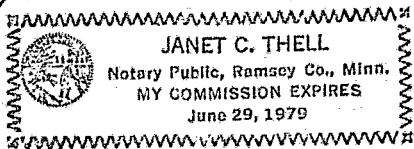
