At a regular meeting of the City Council held December 10 1974

RESOLUTION FOR EARLY ADOPTION OF THE CITY CODE  
IN FORMER STATUTORY CITIES

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING LAWS 1973 CHAPTER 123 (THE UNIFORM CODE OF MUNICIPAL  
GOVERNMENT) AS THE GOVERNING LAW OF THE CITY OF  
THIEF RIVER FALLS

WHEREAS, pursuant to Minnesota Laws 1973 Ch. 123, Art. V, Sec. 5, Subd. 2, the  
City of Thief River Falls will cease to be governed by the Laws of 1895 and be governed  
by the Uniform Code of Municipal Government on July 1, 1975; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the citizens and city government that  
this transition occur as of January 1, 1975, now

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Thief River Falls  
that a copy of this resolution be filed with the Pennington County Auditor, the Minnesota  
State Auditor and the Minnesota Secretary of State, which filing is hereby directed to be  
made by the clerk and effective January 1, 1975, the City of Thief River Falls shall  
henceforth be governed pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, Ch. 412.
