CERTIFICATE OF JUDGES OF SPECIAL ELECTION FOR THE VILLAGE OF COLERAINE, IN ITASCA COUNTY, MINNESOTA, CERTIFYING THE RESULTS OF THE SPECIAL ELECTION HELD IN SAID VILLAGE ON SEPTEMBER 26, 1922. FOR THE DETACHING OF CERTAIN PROPERTY FROM SAID VILLAGE PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF CHAPTER 132, LAWS OF MINNESOTA. FOR 1911.

WHEREAS, a petition, signed by more than thirty of the legal voters of the Village of Coleraine, in Itasca County, Minnesota, petitioning for the detaching of certain lands from said Village and accurately describing the lands proposed to be detached, was filed with the Village Recorder of said Village on September 12th, 1922, and notice thereof given to the Village Council; and within ten days thereafter to-wit: on September 13th, 1922, a special meeting of said Council, with all members present, was held and a resolution passed and adopted ordering a special election to be called and held in said Village for the electors of said Village to vote upon the proposition of detaching such territory from said Village; a copy of which petition and resolution and order is hereto attached; and

WHEREAS, ten days! notice of said election was given by posting three notices thereof in three of the most public places within said Village, outset said territory to be detached and in three of the most public places within the territory to be detached, stating the time and place, when and where within said Village said election should be held and also stating the proposition to be voted upon, and having attached thereto and as a part of said notice, a copy of the said petition giving a full description of the land proposed to be detached; and

WHEREAS said notice, including said petition was published prior to said election for one week in a newspaper printed and published in said Village, all as appears from the original records on file in the office of the Recorder of said Village of Coleraine including the said petition, resolution and order for election and the affairmetof posting and publishing of said notice;

THEREAFTER and within thirty days from the time of filing said petition in the office of the Village Recorder of said Village of Coleraine, to-wit: On September 26th, 1922, a special election was held within said Village at the time and place stated in said notice, for the purpose of voting upon the proposition therein named and the ballots used thereat had printed upon them the proposition to be voted upon "For detaching" and the words "Against detaching" and said special election was held and conducted as other special elections in villages pursuant to the General Lews of Linnesota.

This is to certify that the Judges of soid special election, duly appointed for seid purpose by said Village Council, were Anna Ramquist and Sadie L. Blain, and the Clerk of said election, duly appointed by said Village Council, was Harry E. Mc-Kereghan; and that the description of the territory to be detached as set forth in notice of said election, was as follows:

The South-east Quarter of the South-east Quarter (SE4 of SE4) of Section Twenty (20);

The West one-half $(\mathbb{V}_{\mathbb{R}}^1)$ of Section twenty-eight (28); The East one-half of the North-east Quarter (E2 of NE1) of Section Twenty-nine

(29); The North one-half of the South-east Quarter (No of SE4) of Section Toney-nine

(29), except the south four hundred (400) feet thereof;

The North-east Quarter of the South-west Quarter (NE of SWA) of Section Twentynine (29), except the south four hundred (400) feet thereof, all in Township Fifty-six North of Range Twenty-four West of the 4th P. M. in Minnesota, said lands being bounded as follows:

Beginning on the section line between sections twenty and twenty-one (20 and 21) at the North-east corner of said SE4 of SE4 of said Section 20; thence south upon and along said section line to the section corners of sections 20, 21, 28 and 29, thence East upon and along the section line between said section 21 and 28 to the Quarterpost of said section 28, seme being the north-east corner of the West one-half (Wg) of said section 28; thence south upon and along the north and south quarter line of

The whole number of votes cast were one hundred sixty-five (165), the number of votes cast for detaching were one hyndred thirty-four (134), the number of votes cast against detaching were thirty-one (31)
