



# Proclamation

REAS: the Twin City Society of X-Ray Technicians met on March 9, 1939 to adopt the By-Laws and Constitution of the American Society of Radiologic Technologists, and to make an effort to bring all affiliated societies of radiologic technologists under the aegis of the ASRT; and

REAS: a committee of registered radiologic technologists formulated plans regarding organization of the Minnesota Society on September 8, 1939. The Committee met in November at the home of Alfred Greene, R. T. (ASRT) to make plans for the first meeting; and

REAS: on December 10, 1938, the new Minnesota Society of Radiologic Technologists officially became an affiliate of ASRT; and

REAS: the dedication of the 1800 Registered Radiologic Technologists of the State of Minnesota is testimony of their concern for improving the quality of patient care through radiation protection, continuing education and the need to exchange technical information; and

REAS: the Minnesota Society of Radiologic Technologists will hold their 37th annual meeting in Bloomington on October 2, 3 and 4, 1975;

THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of September 28 through October 4, 1975 to be

in honor of the dedicated technologists who live and work in the State of Minnesota.
