ORDINANCE # 18.

An ordinance annexing certain lots, blocks and lands to the Village of Waubun, Mahnomen County, Minnesota.

The village council of the Village of Waubun, do ordain as follows:

SECTION I. That the following described lots, blocks and lands, abutting upon the incorporated village of Waubun, described as follows;

Blocks twenty-five, (25), twenty-six (26), twenty-seven (27), ~~twenty-eight~~ twenty-eight (28), twenty-nine (29) and thirty (30) of Wallers Addition to the Village of Waubun, in township one hundred forty-three (143) Range forty-two (42); also the unplatted portions of the Northeast quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) and the East half ( $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the Northwest quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section twenty-four (24) in township one hundred forty-three (143) Range forty-two (42), containing 240 acres more or less, be and the same are hereby annexed to such village and shall become a part of such village as effectually as if they had been originally a part thereof.

SECTION II. This ordinance shall take effect after its publication, and a certified copy has been filed with the Secretary of the State of Minnesota.
