Gentlemen:-This is to notify you as State
Officials that the undersigned, a citizen of
Hawley, Minn., is today making application to
the Commissioner of the General Land Office,
Washington, D. C. for a survey of an unsurveyed
island in a lake in Secs. 9 and 16 in township
18P N., 7 Range 44 W. of 5th. P. M. in Clay Co.,
Minn.

I understand that the State of Minn. has
selected and had approved to it other lands as
indemnity for loss of lands on account of the
deficiency in area of the township, including
the deficiency in areas of Sections 16 and 36,
to the full extent she is entitled to receive,
excepting 16-100 of an acre, hence is not
interested in the disposal of this island.

Will the State Auditor kindly acknowledge
receipt of this letter and so state that I may
send his letter with my application for survey?
