



Proclamation

WHEREAS: Lions International is a service organization with a global commitment to help people in need; and

WHEREAS: Lions International has designated October 8 as a day to express Lionism in action; and

WHEREAS: on that day Lions everywhere will carry out a humanitarian project, an activity that involves the total club membership; and

WHEREAS: World Lions Service Day is an effort to demonstrate what Lions everywhere do throughout the year on behalf of their communities and sick, needy and handicapped people; and

WHEREAS: World Lions Service Day on October 8 will be a day when more than one million men give of themselves to perform acts of kindness on behalf of the less fortunate or to actively participate in programs benefiting their communities;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota do hereby proclaim Wednesday, October 8, 1975 to be

WORLD LIONS SERVICE DAY

in Minnesota.
