



WHEREAS: Metropolitan State University was created by the Minnesota Legislature and approved by the Governor in 1971; and

WHEREAS: Metropolitan State University enrolled its first students in February 1972; and

WHEREAS: Metropolitan State University has been granted full accreditation by the North Central Association of Colleges and Schools in July 1975; and

WHEREAS: Metropolitan State University achieved full accreditation in less time than any other university has ever done; and

WHEREAS: Metropolitan State University operates without a campus using buildings and facilities throughout the seven county metropolitan area; and

HEREAS: Metropolitan State University has been nationally and internationally hailed as a model for a new kind of student-centered, urban higher education; and

WHEREAS: on October 4 and 5 Metropolitan State University will honor its nearly 500 graduo and celebrate its accreditation by holding a commencement and accreditation convocation to award degrees to over 125 graduates;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby procl Sunday, October 5, 1975, as
