ORDINANCE #372

An Ordinance Annexing Territory Herein Described to the City of Shakopee

WHEREAS, All the owners of the territory described herein have petitioned the Shakopee City Council to annex the territory to the City of Shakopee and to extend the city boundaries to include the same.

THEREFORE, THE SHAKOPEE CITY COUNCIL DOES ORDAIN:

SECTION I: Prerequisites

The City Council of the City of Shakopee hereby determines:

A. That the territory to be annexed consists entirely of lands which are presently in the process of development and necessary public services and facilities can only be obtained from the City of Shakopee; and all of the land lies entirely within the County of Scott and abuts the City limits of Shakopee and is not included within the corporate limits of an incorporated city,

B. This territory is, or is about to become, urban in character and the petition was filed pursuant to Minnesota Statutes Annotated 414.033 Subd. 5, and does not exceed 200 acres in area.

C. That all the property owners within said tract have petitioned for annexation by ordinance.

D. That copies of said petition have been filed with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Town Board of Jackson Township, the County Board of Scott County and the Shakopee City Council and that more than sixty (60) days have elapsed since said filing and no written objection to said annexation has been filed with the Minnesota Municipal Commission.

E. That the annexation as prayed for will be to the best interests of the municipality and the territory hereinafter described.

SECTION II: Annexation

That the following described territory be, and is hereby annexed to, declared to be and hereby does become a part of the City of Shakopee, to-wit:

The Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter; the Northeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter; that part of the Northwest Quarter of Southwest Quarter lying southeasterly of the southeasterly right-of-way line of U.S. Highway #169, except that part thereof described as follows: Commencing at the intersection of the north line of said Southwest Quarter and the southeasterly right-of-way line of said U.S. Highway #169 and running thence southwesterly along said southeasterly right-of-way line a distance of 244.30 feet to the actual point of beginning of the tract of land being excepted; thence southeasterly and at right angles to said southeasterly right-of-way line a distance of 400 feet; thence south-

westerly and parallel to said southeasterly right-of-way a distance of 376.25 feet; thence northwesterly and at right angles to said southeasterly right-of-way a distance of 400 feet; thence northeasterly along said southeasterly right-of-way a distance of 376.25 feet to the point of beginning; together with that part of the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter lying southeasterly of the southeasterly right-of-way line of U.S. Highway #169; together with that part of the Southeast Quarter of Northwest Quarter lying southeasterly of the southeasterly right-of-way line of U.S. Highway #169 and also lying southeasterly of the southeasterly right-of-way line of Legislative Route #300; together with that part of Government Lot 2 lying southeasterly of the southeasterly right-of-way line of Legislative Route #300. All the above being in Section 11, Township 115, Range 23, Scott County, Minnesota.

SECTION III: When in Force

This annexation shall become effective upon the passage and publication of this ordinance as provided by law and the following filing of certified copies of this ordinance as required by Section IV hereof.

SECTION IV: Filing and Recording

Upon the passage and publication hereof, the City Clerk shall forthwith file a certified copy of this ordinance with the following: (A) The Minnesota Municipal Commission; (B) The Town Clerk of Jackson Township; (C) The Scott County Auditor; (D) The Secretary of State of Minnesota; (E) The Register of Deeds of Scott County.
