AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN LANDS INTO THE CITY OF THIEF RIVER FALLS BY PETITION OF THE PROPERTY OWNER.

The City Council of Thief River Falls ordains:

Section 1. The owner of all of the following described property situated in the County of Pennington and State of Minnesota, to-wit:

A parcel of land which is part of the N $\frac{1}{2}$  of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  and S $\frac{1}{2}$  of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , T. 153N., R. 43W. bounded as follows:

Beginning at a point on the centerline of Minnesota Trunk Highway #32 which point lies S 17° 17' 51" W a distance of 990.62 feet from the intersection of the southerly line extended of Block 1, Oakland Park Second Addition and the centerline of said Minnesota Trunk Highway #32; thence S 72° 42' 09" E a distance of 75 feet to the east Right-of-way line of said Minnesota Trunk Highway #32; thence S 80° 32' E a distance of 108.45 feet; thence S 27° 07' 04" E a distance of 474.22 feet to the northerly 33 feet Right-of-way line of County Aid Road #62; thence southwesterly along said northerly Right-of-way line extended to an intersection with the centerline of said Minnesota Trunk Highway #32; thence N 17° 17' 51" E along said centerline to the point of beginning; containing 5.9 acres more or less,

having filed a petition with the City Council to have said property annexed to and included within the city limits of the City of Thief River Falls and copies thereof having been filed with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Town Board of the Township of Rocksbury and the County Board of the County of Pennington and no objection to said annexation having been received within sixty (60) days from the time of filing thereof the City Council does hereby determine that the annexation will be to the best interests of the City of Thief River Falls and of the territory affected and said land is hereby declared to be annexed to the City of Thief River Falls.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication.
