



Proclamation

WHEREAS: December 7, 1975 marks the 34th anniversary of Pearl Harbor; and

WHEREAS: December 7 recalls a day that Americans will never forget and whose significance must be taught to our youth; and

WHEREAS: the Pearl Harbor survivors stand as a living testimony of our continuing obligation to be prepared to defend ourselves;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim December 7, 1975 as

PEARL HARBOR REMEMBRANCE DAY

in Minnesota and urge attention to the proper commemoration of this event in American history, and due honor to the defenders of Pearl Harbor.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this fifteenth day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred seventy-five and of the State the one hundred seventeenth.
