



Proclamation

WHEREAS: *the Salvation Army has rendered devoted service to God and man for more than 100 years, and has ministered to the spiritual and material needs of the people of Minnesota since 1869; and*

WHEREAS: *the Salvation Army, since its founding, has considered all men to be children of God, and has recognized no distinction of color, creed, or national origin among His sons; and*

WHEREAS: *one of the ways the Salvation Army raises funds is through its "Kettle Campaign" during the Christmas season;*

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the period November 1 through December 24, 1975 to be

CHRISTMAS APPEAL DAYS

in Minnesota, and encourage all citizens to hear the Salvation Army bell ringers and to help support its many compassionate projects by filling the "Christmas Kettles".
