WHEREAS: our Creator has bestowed upon the people of this Nation and this State immeasurable blessings, including great material treasure to be used for man's needs and not his pleasure or glory; a rich environment to be cherished and preserved; an ever increasing reservoir of knowledge which can help man conquer disease, poverty, superstition and ignorance; a great spiritual heritage; and a form of government vesting in the people the power to shape their own destiny;

NOW, THEREFORE, to show our humble appreciation for the innumerable gifts granted us by our Maker, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Thursday, November 27, 1975 as a Day of Statewide
