PROCLAMATION


The American Red Cross will make its annual roll call from November 11th to 30th. It is asking its members to renew their membership for another year, and inviting others to join the organization.

Since the close of the World War, the Red Cross has done wonderful work in caring for disabled service men and their dependents. It has organized a public health service which has given direct aid to thousands of people and which has done splendid educational work in this field. It is ever ready in case of disaster to give emergency relief and to look after the rehabilitation of the victims. Through its Junior Red Cross activities it is working with the younger generation for better health and clean living. In the suffering nations of Europe, the Red Cross is our messenger of mercy, service and good will.

NOW THEREFORE, I, J. A. O. Preus, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby call upon the citizens of this state to give their support and cooperation to the Red Cross in this campaign and urge them to renew their membership, if they are members, or to join the organization, if they have not already done so.

An effort is being made to enlist 6,000,000 men and women in the Nation. Minnesota is asked to enroll 135,000. With our large population of generous, public spirited citizens, we should surpass this quota by several thousand. The Red Cross is efficiently organized and splendidly equipped for its work and we cannot afford to allow it to lack the support it needs.
