ORDINANCE NO. 145

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF ROSEAU, MINNESOTA, TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNPLATTED LAND NOT EXCEEDING TWO HUNDRED (200) ACRES IN AREA ABUTTING UPON THE CITY LIMITS.

WHEREAS, a certain Petition dated September 11, 1975, requesting annexation of the territory hereinafter described was duly presented to the council on the 17th day of September, 1975; and

WHEREAS, the quantity of land embraced within the area described in the Petition and bounded as described is three (3) acres, more or less, of unplatted land, no part of which is included within the limits of incorporated city or borough; and

WHEREAS, the Petition was signed by all owners; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of Jadis Township, Roseau County, Minnesota, had executed a Consent to said Annexation, and no objections to the Annexation have been received from the Town Board, or the governing body of any municipality whose boundaries abut upon the boundaries of the land to be annexed; and

WHEREAS, the land described in the Petition abuts upon the city limits at the northern boundary thereof;

The Council of the City of Roseau, Minnesota, ordains:

Section 1. The City Council hereby determines that the annexation will be in the best interests of the City and of the territory affected; that the territory herein abuts upon the city limits and is about to become urban or suburban in character; and that none of said territory is now included within the limits of any city or borough.

Section 2. Territory Annexed. The corporate limits of the city are hereby extended to include unplatted land described as follows and the same is hereby annexed to and included within the City as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof:


The East Seven Hundred Ninety-one and Forty-four hundredths (791.44) feet of the South

One Hundred Sixty-five (165) feet of the Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Thirteen (13), in Township One Hundred Sixty-two (162) North, Range Forty (40) West, according to the United States Government Survey thereof, Roseau County, Minnesota.

Section 3. Filing. The City Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this Ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Secretary of State, the Town Clerk, and the County Auditor.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication and the filing of the certified copies as directed in Section 3.

Adopted by the City Council of the City of Roseau, Minnesota, this 17th day of September, 1975.


