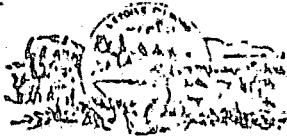



ORDINANCE NO. 10

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF GHENT TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNPLATTED LAND NOT EXCEEDING TWO HUNDRED ACRES.

The Common Council of the City of Ghent does ordain as follows:

Section 1. Petitions have been filed with the Common Council of the City of Ghent, Minnesota, by the sole owners of the following described real estate in the County of Lyon, State of Minnesota, to have such land included within the City of Ghent, Minnesota:

Block One (1), except highway, Original Plat, Village of Ghent, Lyon County, Minnesota,  
ALSO  
Outlot "B" in the Subdivision entitled "Outlots A, B & C", Section Fifteen (15), Township One Hundred Twelve (112), Range Forty-two (42), Lyon County Minnesota, containing 6.90 acres, more or less

Section 2. The quantity of land embraced within the foregoing description, and bounded and described, is 6.90 acres, more or less.

Section 3. The Common Council hereby determine (1) that the annexation will be to the best interests of the City of Ghent, Minnesota, and of the territory affected; and (2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the City and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to city government.

Section 4. Therefore, the City of Ghent, Minnesota, hereby ordains and declares that the properties hereinbefore described be, and the same are hereby annexed to, and included in, the City of Ghent, Minnesota, as effectually as if they had been originally a part thereof.

Section 5. This ordinance shall be final and shall take effect and be in force from and after filing a certified copy hereof with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Town Clerk of Grandview Township, the County Auditor of Lyon County and the Secretary of State, and from and after its passage and publication.

of said Ordinance No. 40 the publisher or printer in charge of said newspaper having knowledge of the facts, filed in the office of the county auditor of said county of Lyon, State of Minnesota, an affidavit showing the name and location of said newspaper, and the existence of conditions constituting its qualifications as a legal newspaper as required and set forth in section 3 of chapter 484, Session Laws of Minnesota, 1921.




