



Proclamation

WHEREAS: *Ski for Light, Inc., a nonprofit Minnesota corporation, is sponsoring a cross-country ski race for the blind at the Honeywell Country Club in Lakeville, Minnesota, on Sunday, February 1, 1976; and*

WHEREAS: *blind participants from four countries - Norway, Sweden, Canada and the United States, will be competing in this international event; and*

WHEREAS: *these blind guests, their individual sponsors, committee members, and officials of these various nations, will be in our state preparing for this occasion all during the week of training preceding the race;*

NOW, THEREFORE I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota do hereby proclaim the week of Sunday, January 25 to Sunday, February 1, 1976, as

"SKI FOR LIGHT WEEK"

in Minnesota, and commend to the people of our state support for this and other programs which promote athletic activities for the blind and all other handicapped citizens.
