WHEREAS: the tradition of volunteerism as practiced for 82 years by the National Council of Jewish Women has been an effective means of changing and improving society through programs of social action, education and community service; and

WHEREAS: the need for committed individuals to champion the cause of the poor, the aged, and the disadvantaged continues to grow as our society becomes more automated and impersonal; and

WHEREAS: the women of Council have continually prepared themselves, by developing their talents and skills, to translate the ideas of freedom and equality for all into a reality for our community today;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota do hereby proclaim the week of January 19 - 26, 1976 as

in Minnesota.
