AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF SLAYTON, MURRAY COUNTY, MINNESOTA, TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED PLATTED LAND ABUTTING UPON THE CITY LIMITS.

WHEREAS, a certain petition requesting annexation of the territory hereinafter described was presented to the City on the 25th day of October 1973; and

WHEREAS, the quantity of land embraced within the area described in the petition and bounded as described is ten (10) acres of platted land, no part of which is included within the limits of an incorporated city, or borough; and

WHEREAS, the petition was signed by all owners; and

WHEREAS, no objections to the annexation have been received from the town board, or the governing body of any municipality whose boundaries abut upon the boundaries of the land to be annexed; and

WHEREAS, the land described in the petition abuts upon the city limits at the west boundary thereof;

The City Council of Slayton, Murray County, Minnesota, ordains:

Section 1. The City Council hereby determines (1) that the annexation will be to the best interests of the city and of the territory affected; (2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the city limits and is urban or suburban in character; and (3) that none of said territory is now included within the limits of any city, or borough.

Section 2. Territory Annexed. The corporate limits of the city are hereby extended to include the platted land described as follows and the same is hereby annexed to and included within the city as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof:

A tract of land in the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 16, Township 106 North, Range 41, West of the Fifth Principal Meridian, in Slayton Township, Murray County, Minnesota, described as follows: Beginning at a point on the East Section Line 316.56 feet South of the Northeast corner of said Section 16, also described as the Northwest corner of Lot 7 of Gullord Park Addition in the Village of Slayton, Minnesota, thence on a bearing line North 63° - 58' West a distance of 288.17 feet; thence South 0° - 15' West a distance of 167.65 feet; thence North 90° - 00' West a distance of 300.00 feet; thence North 0° - 15' East a distance of 133.50 feet; thence South 89° - 15' - 40" West a distance of 40.00 feet; thence South 0° - 15' West a distance of 770.18 feet; thence North 89° - 45' East a distance of 598.90 feet; thence North 0° - 12' East a distance of 675.00 feet to the point of beginning, known as "WESTPARK ADDITION TO THE VILLAGE OF SLAYTON, MINNESOTA".

Section 3. Filing. The City Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this Ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Secretary of State, the Town Clerk, and the County Auditor.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication and the filing of the certified copies as directed in Section 3.
